Dear Parents, Students, Employees, Visitors:

In 1986, Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). This required schools to be inspected to identify any asbestos-containing building materials. The Kansas City, Missouri School District buildings were inspected as required and appropriate asbestos remediation projects have been conducted over the years.

In accordance with AHERA, an Asbestos Management Plan has been developed for each school building. You are welcome to review a copy of the Plan upon request; please contact the District's Designated AHERA contact person at the phone number below.

The District is in the process of soliciting proposals for the required triennial re-inspection to determine if any known or suspected asbestos-containing building materials have changed and to receive recommendations on managing or removing such materials.

It is the intention of the District to comply with all federal and state regulations controlling asbestos and to take whatever steps are necessary to ensure students and employees a healthy and safe environment in which to learn and work.
